▲ **Know: We have God-given potential.**

▲ **Go: Where will you go with us?**

Getting Started: Describe your driving style. Make a list of all the things you learn from these verses about being a witness of Jesus (Mt 4:19; Lk 5:10-11; 24:47-49; Acts 1:8; 2:42-47; Rom 10:14-15). What clear commands does he make? What was the cause of the result we see in Acts 2:47?

Living It Out: Share your best experience of loving a lost and broken world. On a scale of 1 -10, how confident are you that God has invested redemptive potential in the church? What do you think keeps you and others from experiencing our potential for loving a lost and broken world? How will you “go with us” to love a lost and broken world this year? Will you: a) seek to glorify Jesus at your work and in your family, b) pray regularly for a missionary, c) participate in a local outreach project, d) pray for a lost friend, e) go on a missions trip, f) fill out a faith promise card?
