What is your best guess about why Judas betrayed Jesus in this way? Why was it important that Jesus felt the shame of being treated as a common criminal (Isa 53:3, 7-9, 12)? Why was it important to Mark to include verses 50 and 51 in his story (Mk 3:14, 14:31)? How has Jesus warned His disciples many times that following Him would not be easy—even dangerous (Mk 9:31, 10:21, 38, 43-45, 13:13; Lk 6:22; Jn 15:8)? What did the disciples want more than Jesus at this moment of abandonment?
