**GETTING STARTED:** As a child, what did you want to be when you grew up? Are you doing that now?

**DIGGING DEEPER:** No doubt Moses, had a burden for his people. What are you burdened for? What keeps you up at night? What are you passionate about? Moses had some obvious leadership gifts, and that combined with his training, made him a formidable leader. Read Ephesians 2:10. How has God gifted you? What experiences, talents or abilities have you acquired along the way that complement your gifting? How are you using it to do things God's way? Read Exodus 33:15. How does this comment of Moses reflect the change that has occurred in his attitude toward doing thing's God's way? What does he value most? What changes have you seen in your attitude? How has that affected your dependence on God?

**LIVING IT OUT:** Can you relate to Moses in this passage? Have you ever felt like you were pursuing the right thing and then realized that you had gone about it in the wrong way? What happened? Have you recovered?

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
