Getting Started: Tell about some kind of reward you received (a trophy as a child, a monetary bonus, a promotion, etc.). What did you do to earn the reward? Did you sacrifice anything? What? How did you think and feel when you received the reward?

Digging In: How does Is 53:10-12 work out the promise in Is 52:13? What does Jesus do in these verses? What does the Father do for Jesus (also see the verses under each outline point)? Look back over Is 53, and observe all that was involved for Jesus to become a guilt offering. Seeing these things, how would you describe the consequences of sin?

Living It Out: As a group read the verses under each outline point. Which is most meaningful to you? Why? Take time to worship Jesus in light of these things. What one thing will you do this week as an act of praise to the exalted Jesus? Each day this week read Is 52:13-53:12 and prayerfully consider these three questions: (1) How would my life be different if I understood this picture of Jesus more clearly? (2) Appreciated it more deeply? (3) Owned it more fully?
