



Door A and Door B (part II)

Matthew 14:1-21

- It matters to Jesus when friends die.
- It matters to Jesus when people suffer.
- It matters to Jesus that people matter to His followers.

Getting Started: Explain Door A and Door B. What joys and pains does your door B consist of right now?

Digging In: What do you make of Jesus' actions when he hears the report of John the Baptist's death? Who has died who was close to you? How did you feel? In light of this passage, how do you think Jesus felt when your friend died? What was Jesus' physical and emotional state when all the people were coming to Him in vv.13-15? Who is suffering that is close to you? How do you feel when you see this? In light of verse 14, how do you think Jesus feels toward that person right now? How does the story of feeding the 5000 connect with the previous stories of John the Baptist and Jesus caring for the crowds? What lessons about caring for people do you take from the feeding of the 5000?

Living It Out: In what ways have you seen God use you to care for others in Door B out of your own Door B experience? How will you trust him this week to stretch you beyond your resources to bring the gospel to others through practical caring?
