What insight do these verses give to our great stupidity: Pr 26:11,12; Is 55:8, 9; Mk 3:5, 7:18, 8:17, 21,12:24; 1 Cor 1:25-31? What insight do these verses give to our great value: Gen 1:26-28; Ps 8, 139; Jn 3:16; Ro 8:32? How does the Shepherd fight for the sheep?

Living It Out: How have you seen your helplessness? How do you try to deny your helplessness? How have you seen your stupidity, even in past mistakes? How do you try to deny your stupidity? Why is it so important to recognize your helplessness and stupidity? Do you see yourself as valued by God? How is that revealed in your life? Do you believe the Good Shepherd wants to fight for you? Make a list of situations last week that you could have stopped and prayed, "Good Shepherd, for Your glory, fight for me." When will you pray this prayer this week? How can you remind yourself?
