□ **Josiah's Story: A model for Read, Listen, Respond**

□ **When was the last time you read the Word of God and responded by saying:**

"I AM WRONG"

□ **Before you read the Word pray:**

"GOD BREAK MY HEART"

Getting Started: Why is it hard to say, "I am wrong"?

Digging In: Read 2 Kings 22-23. What insight do the following verses give concerning the quality of Josiah as a king in Israel: 2 Kings 22:2; 3-7; 18-20; 23:25? Make a list of at least 15 things Josiah did in response to hearing the word of God. What did he do immediately? What did he do over time? Why were these actions significant? In what ways was he saying to God, "I am wrong"? (see 22:11,19).

Living It Out: How do you tend to approach the Word of God: desperate for change or fascinated with knowledge? What is the possible danger in fascination with knowledge (John 5:39-40; 1 Cor 8:1-3; 13:2)? How do you tend to approach the Word of God: looking for evidence that you are right or looking to see how God alone is right? When was the last time you read the Word and responded by saying, "I am wrong"? With tears? With grief? With significant life change? What do the following verses say about the person who cannot take in information to show them where and how they are wrong: Prv 12:1,13,15-16; 13:8; 14:9; 15:12; 29:1? This week as you read the Word of God, ask God to soften your heart.
